A girl comes home to find her house has disappeared. Her neighbours have fled and the streets are deserted. **her** is the story of a fifteen year old British girl who inexplicably finds that conflict has made her an alien in her own country.

This compelling play features one actor playing five different versions of the 'girl' as she navigates the harsh realities faced by young people in conflict and the difficult choices they have to make to survive.

Using innovative green screen technologies to integrate animation, film and live action, **her** combines the emotional depth of theatre with the visual intensity of the graphic novel to create a dark and twisted world of politics, war and survival.



### **Technical Requirements:**

Get-in: get-in to the theatre/studio space 4 hours before half with pre-rigin advance.

Get-out: the same day as the last performance (2 hours).

Minimum of 2 hours between the start of shows (e.g. 11 am & 1 pm)

Venue Configuration: The performance takes place end on. Audiences siton raked seating provided by the venue. The dimensions of the performance space needed is a minimum 7m (depth) by 8m (width), with a height of 3m approx. Please request diagram of layout. (This area includes the back projector. The front projector will hang above the audience seating)

We recommend that a maximum of 200 audience members is adhered towhere possible due to the intimate nature of the production.

Technical staff: 2 technicians to assist with get-in/out. It may be required that one technician will need to operate with company's touring stage manager.

Parking and get-in for one long wheel base van.

Dressing room for one performer.
